



Munster III Facility has been handed over by DYNASAFE



As of 25 April 2006 Munster III, the plant for the destruction of Germany's old chemical weapons, has been handed over to the client. After the contract had been placed to DYNASAFE, the engineering started in September 2003, the granting of approval by the German authorities was in March 2004, erection and fabrication started in March 2004 and commissioning (cold and hot commissioning) started in late 2005. The owner of the plant, GEKA (Gesellschaft des Bundes zur Entsorgung chemischer Kampfstoffe und Rüstungs-Altlasten mbH) in Munster is the central facility for the disposal of chemical warfare agents and material contaminated with such agents in Germany. Munster III is the first one step destruction plant for old chemical munitions worldwide. During the 2006 Chemical Weapons Destruction Conference – CWD 2006 – more than 200 delegates from 16 countries had the possibility to visit this latest and most modern add to the chemical weapons destruction technologies.
